Getting to & from the Ottawa Airport

Public Transit

Take the 97, the 97A, or the 97B City bus

- The bus leaves from pillar 14 outside the Level one Arrivals area, and runs about every 15 minutes.
- Get off at Mackenzie King Station, which is a very short walk from the Novotel Hotel and the Ottawa Art Gallery.

Cost is \$3.30 per person.

- Bus tickets can be purchased from the transportation desk in the airport, located on level one at the central door of the arrivals area.
- If you pay cash, you must have exact change or lose your change, because they do not have the ability to give change on the bus.

To return to the airport by bus: you must only take bus 97. Bus 97A and 97B do <u>not</u> go to the airport.

Ottawa buses are accessible.

By Car

Taxi – approximately 30 minutes, \$35.00 - \$50.00 (plus tax and tip)

Limousines to or from the airport can be reserved in advance through Elite Limousine (888-901-6222)

By Shuttle

The Novotel, the Lord Elgin, and Les Suites hotels do <u>not</u> have shuttles to/from the airport.

By Car

Taxi – approximately 15 minutes, \$35.00 - \$50.00 (plus tax and tip)
